**RESOLUTION OF
THE VILLAGE OF MARTIN'S ADDITIONS**

**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TO RESTRICT PARKING ON CERTAIN
VILLAGE STREETS DURING HEAVY SNOWFALL**

WHEREAS, Section 2(a) of Article 23A of the Maryland Code grants to the legislative body of every incorporated municipality in Maryland, including the Village of Martin's Additions, general power to pass such ordinances not contrary to the Constitution of Maryland or public general law as they may deem necessary in order to assure the good government of the municipality, to protect and preserve the municipality's rights, property, and privileges, to preserve peace and good order, to secure persons and property from danger and destruction, and to protect the health, comfort and convenience of the citizens of the municipality;

WHEREAS, Section 8-103 of the Village of Martin's Additions Code of Ordinances authorizes the Village Council to authorize the Village Manager to erect traffic and parking control signs when deemed appropriate, necessary, or advisable for the public good, safety, or convenience; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-107(a) of the Village of Martin's Additions Code of Ordinances authorizes the Village Council to designate by resolution any Village Street or portion thereof as a snow emergency route; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that due to the narrowness of Village streets, and based on the proposed snow removal route submitted by the Village's snow removal contractor, restricting parking to one side of the street during a heavy snowfall is necessary to allow the proper removal of snow on Village streets where parking is provided on both sides of the street (including Chestnut Street, Delfield Street, Summit Avenue, and Melville Place); and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that adopting the foregoing resolution would promote the good government of the Village and protect and preserve the Village's rights, property, and privileges, and would protect and promote the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village, and is appropriate, necessary, and advisable for the public good, safety, and convenience.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is, this 19th day of January, 2012, by the Village Council:

RESOLVED, that the Village Manager be and is hereby authorized to erect temporary "no-parking" signs and other devices on Village streets prior to an anticipated heavy snowfall and during and immediately after a heavy snowfall, in order to limit on-street parking to one side of the street; and it is further,

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective on February 9, 2012.
