

On November 3, 2015, at 7:00 p.m., at 163 Quincy Street, Chevy Chase, Maryland (a private home), the Committee met to discuss how to implement the Village Council's directive: to examine the Village's voting procedures and provide recommendations to the Village Council for any amendments.

The Committee discussed concerns that the residents potentially may have relating to voting procedures, including the handling of absentee ballots, voting procedures and ease of voting, process transparency and ballot protection and confidentiality. The Committee unanimously agreed that a survey should be issued to the Village residents and that e-mail comments should be sought from residents to hear from residents any concerns or suggestions they may have with respect to current VMA voting procedures so that the Committee could address the concerns and suggestions of residents. The establishment of a committee e-mail address for purposes of receiving e-mail comments was approved.

The Committee unanimously agreed that a meeting should be held to discuss the survey responses and e-mail comments and to allow residents to submit additional comments. Tentative dates for the meeting were discussed. No further action was taken at the meeting.

Hearing no objection, Ms. Anderson adjourned the meeting at 8:30 p.m.
